

## **District One Championship Series**

**Revised 4/19/15**

The District One Championship shall be awarded to the skipper who has the highest cumulative point score for the scheduled regattas, using the highpoint scoring system explained below.

### **THE SERIES**

The series will include the following regattas, each hosted by District One Fleets.

Fleet Two, Marina del Rey - January 25, Super Bowl Regatta

Fleet Six, Alamitos Bay - February 21-22, SCYA Mid-Winter Regatta

Fleet Nine, San Pedro - March 8, March Madness Regatta

Fleet Twenty One, Oceanside – March 15, SCYA Mid-Winter Regatta (Rescheduled from Feb. 22)

Fleet One, Newport Harbor - March 22, Harry Wood Regatta

Fleet Seven, Mission Bay - April 25-26, Pete Jefferson Invitational

Fleet Twenty, Santa Barbara - June 27, Semana Nautica

Please check the Lido 14 Class Association website for regatta details.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- To be scored for the Championship Series, you must be a member of the Lido 14 Class Association, and a District One fleet.
- To be scored for the Championship Series, you must sail in the “A” division of each regatta entered unless the A&B fleets are combined.

### **SCORING**

Highpoint Series scoring shall be based on the official results of each regatta.

Points will be awarded as follows:

One (1) point for each event in which scored as a competitor, plus

One (1) point for each “boat” beaten in the final standings of the regatta.

For the purposes of this series, “boats” are defined as members of the Lido 14 Class Association, regardless of Fleet affiliation.

### **TIE BREAKERS**

1. If there is a series score tie between two or more boats, each boat’s regatta scores shall be listed in order of best to worst, and at the first point(s) where there is a difference the tie shall be broken in favor of the boats(s) with the highest score(s).
2. If a tie remains between two boats, it shall be broken in favor of the boat that scores better than the other boat in more regattas.
3. If more than two boats are tied, they shall be ranked in order of the number of times each boat scored better than another of the tied boats.
4. If a tie still remains between two or more races, they shall be ranked in order of their scores in their last regatta.
